- **Task:**This assignment has two purposes:
 - 1) To complement the material covered in this topic, and
 - 2) To prepare for the next topic which focuses on the Australian share market.

Your task is to present a profile of four public companies currently listed on the Australian Stock Exchange AND included in the ASX Schools' Sharemarket Game *Company list*. Each of the four companies is to be drawn from a different industry classification or sector.

Each company profile is to be 250 - 300 words in length and be presented under the following headings:

- Company name
- ASX code
- Industry/Sector group
- Key features of the company (Introduce the company by outlining its principal activities/y, giving a brief historical sketch and mentioning the company's strengths)
- Share price (The current price, recent highs and lows, and dividend payments.)
- Outlook (Comment on the company's growth potential, its market share within the industry it belongs and identify its sustainable competitive advantage.)
- Risks (Comment on its debt position, its sensitivity to: competition, variations in costs, changes of government policy, consumer trends, etc.)

Resources:

There is no shortage of resource material for this assignment. Your first stop should be the Australian Stock Exchange website at <u>www.asx.com.au</u> From this site go to 'Company Research' then 'Company information' or 'Listed companies' to find a long list of companies and relevant information.

- > Most companies have a website of their own. Track it down for more information.
- Magazines such as the 'Business Review Week' will be helpful. The business section of the daily papers is another source of current information.
