Instructions

You are to research one of the following French Provinces:

Brittany
Provence
Normandy

In your research you are to find information on each of the following sections:

1. Religion and religious festivals
2. Food specialities of the region (include one recipe/picture)
3. The history of the region
4. Agriculture and industry found in the region
5. Dress/costume of the region (picture included)
6. The geography of the region (eg climate, landforms, rivers)
7. Tourism in the province.

Your final assignment must include at least 2 maps of the region showing:

1. its position/location in France
2. information about the region such as main cities and towns, places of interest, rivers, lakes etc.

Your assignment should be approximately 4 – 6 typed pages in length, plus maps and a bibliography.

Your maps should follow the rules for “**Essential features of a map**” as covered in class.

You must include a **bibliography** of all reference materials used, including websites. Your bibliography must be completed as you were shown in class.
